

TOP THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE GETTING A NEW ROOF

BE PREPARED FOR NOISE

Roofing crews will most likely start on your roof in the early morning. For the duration of your roof's repair or replacement, there will be constant construction noise.

PROTECT THE OUTSIDE

Move patio furniture, potted plants, gardening equipment, grills, etc. We take precaution to protect your things, however, taking this extra step will help even more.

PROTECT GARAGE ITEMS

If you don't have a ceiling in your garage and can see the bottom side of the roof decking, we recommend to move or cover things that may get damaged such as cars, boats, lawnmowers, & other valuables.

MOVE LOOSE ITEMS

We recommend moving any loose items from walls and shelves such as pictures, plates, and misc decor. Hammering may create vibrations that can shake items off of walls and shelves inside.

WE NEED OUTLETS

We may need to have access to your power outlets for any power tools for decking repair, ridge work, or vent installation. Please be prepared to provide an outlet for our use.

MOVE VEHICLES, CLEAR DRIVEWAY

We will need access to the driveway in order to load the shingles and during the clean up process. Things fall, so please protect your vehicles & other valuables. Keeping these items away from the house and garage while work is being done is smart.
